In an NRC Form 314 dated February 23, 2006, and in a letter dated February 23, 2006, you contacted the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission and indicated that you wished to terminate your byproduct materials license no. 24-26220-02.

The NRC staff has reviewed your final status surveys. Based on its review, the staff has concluded that all licensable radioactive material has been removed from your facilities.

Based on these conclusions, no further remediation or actions with respect to NRC regulated material is required. Your facility is suitable for unrestricted use and NRC license number 24-26220-02 is hereby terminated with the enclosed Amendment No. 03.
