## SYNOPSIS

This investigation was initiated by the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC), Office of Investigations (OI), Region II (RII), on April 25, 2005, to determine whether a Field Engineer Planner with Day & Zimmermann NPS (DZ NPS) at Florida Power and Light's (FPL) St. Lucie Nuclear Plant willfully failed to follow a modification package revision procedure.

Based on the evidence developed during this investigation, OI:RIV did not substantiate that a Field Engineer Planner with DZ NPS at FPL's St. Lucie Nuclear Plant willfully failed to follow a modification package revision procedure.
