Title: "Reports Concerning Possible Non-Routine Emergency Generic Problems," Draft OCP

Current Burden/Responses: 53,680 hours/204 responses

Proposed Burden/Responses: 369,440 hours/1,032 responses

Burden Attributable to Third-Party Collections: None

Frequency of Response: On occasion

Reasons for Changes in Burden/Responses:

The number of responses has increased from 204 to 1,032, and the burden has increased from 53,680 hours to 369,440 hours because of the inclusion of anticipated expedited issuances required for safeguards issues. The cost has increased because of the increased burden and because the hourly cost rate has increased from \$156 to \$205 per hour for reactor licensees and from \$152 to \$197 per hour for materials licensees.
