Dear Dr. Olivenstein:

This is in reference to your letter dated February 7, 2006 requesting to amend Nuclear Regulatory Commission License No. 37-30945-01. In order to continue our review, we need the following additional information:

1. Your application should have been signed by yourself rather than Dawn E. Weaver. Please submit a letter signed by the designated management representative indicating that management has reviewed the application and concurs in the statements and representations contained therein. Note also that a management representative should sign all future correspondence that requests a change in your license.
2. You have requested Dr. Alan E. Olivenstein to be placed on the license as an authorized user. As required by 10 CFR 35.290, for personnel who are certified by a medical specialty board whose certification process has been recognized by the Commission, must meet the requirements in paragraph ©)(2) of 10 CFR 35.290. Section ©)(2) states that you must obtain a written attestation, signed by a preceptor authorized user who meets the requirements in 10 CFR 35.290 or 35.390 and 35.290(c)(1)(ii)(G), or, before October 24, 2005, 10 CFR 35.920, or equivalent Agreement State requirements, that the individual has satisfactorily completed the requirements in paragraph (a)(1) or ©)(1) of this section and has achieved a level of competency sufficient to function independently as an authorized user for the medical uses authorized under §§ 35.100 and 35.200.

Please submit the attestation statement. It is recommended to document the attestation statement on an NRC Form 313A (enclosed).
