In a telephone conversation on April 16, 1996, from Ms. Julie Curtiss of the Navajo Superfund Project, the Nuclear Regulatory Commission staff was advised of concerns you have about the United Nuclear Corporation (UNC) Church Rock site. I have summarized and abbreviated what we understand to be your concerns as follows.

- UNC failed to follow procedures concerning the handling of yellowcake.
- 2. You have health problems related to exposure to yellowcake.
- 3. UNC switched exposure records for some employees.
- 4. UNC may have buried various items from the mill at the Church Rock site without informing NRC.
- 5. UNC performed site cleanup prior to NRC inspections.

If the foregoing is not a complete and accurate description of your concerns, please contact me or Mr. Wise, as listed below, immediately.

It is the policy of the NRC normally not to disclose the identity of a person providing information to NRC (an "alleger") to any organization, individual, or the public. However, there are certain limitations or exceptions to the NRC non-disclosure policy, the occurrence of which might result in the disclosure of an alleger's identity. Those limitations or exceptions are as follows: (1) the alleger has no objection to his or her identity being disclosed; (2) disclosure is necessary in the event of an emergency (danger to public health or safety); (3) disclosure is necessary to inform Congress or State or Federal agencies in furtherance of NRC responsibilities under law or public trust; or (4) the alleger has taken actions that are inconsistent with and override the purpose of protecting the alleger's identity, e.g., disclosing his or her identity and the allegation to the media.
