
On October 8, 1996, [ ] was interviewed at United Nuclear Corporation (UNC), by Special Agent Robert J. Kirspel, Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC), Office of Investigations, Region IV (RIV), and Linda McLEAN, Senior Health Physicist, NRC:RIV. [ ] has been employed by UNC as a [ ]

[ ] stated that former UNC employee, [ ] had never expressed any safety concerns about anything at UNC to him. [ ] stated he had worked with [ ] at UNC and considered him [ ] to be an unreliable employee. [ ] stated that [ ] would not do his share of the work when he [ ] was assigned to work with him. [ ] stated that [ ] he

[ ] stated he was in charge of decontaminating the wood staves which were shipped from UNC. [ ] stated he planed all the wood staves which were shipped from UNC and had [ ] while planing them. [ ] stated there were not any staves that were not properly decontaminated prior to shipping.

[ ] stated he was not aware of any improper practices at UNC and had no safety concerns to report.
