7C On September 29, 1997, [redacted], former UNC employee, was interviewed by
Special Agent Dennis Boal, Office of Investigations (OI), Region IV, with
assistance by Linda McLean, Senior Health Physicist, Nuclear Materials Safety
and Safeguards, NRC:RIV, regarding his allegations about the falsification of
windblown tailing surveys and discrimination for identifying safety concerns.

7C On September 30, 1997, [redacted] UNC, was
interviewed about his alleged harassment and intimidation of [redacted] and
provided a signed, sworn statement.

7C Attached is a copy of the transcript of interview and the signed, sworn
statement for your review to determine if [redacted] was engaged in protected
activities and if he may have been the subject of employment discrimination,
harassment, and intimidation. Since the OI investigation is pending, please
ensure that appropriate measures are taken to safeguard the dissemination of
the transcript and related information. Further, we request you provide a
written response regarding your review.
