**LICENSEE:**


- 1. Based on the inspection findings, no violations were identified.

**Contrary to 10 CR 30.34(i) which requires each portable gauge licensee shall use a minimum of two independent physical controls that form tangible barriers to secure portable gauges from unauthorized removal, whenever portable gauges are not under the control and constant surveillance of the licensee. The licensee vehicle-mounted transportation boxes are secured by only one method. The licensee stated that a second method would be added to all boxes.**
