Cabrera Services Inc. (CABRERA) is providing this written notification of its intent to utilize CABRERA Material License #06-30556-01 at a temporary job site. A revision to the initial notification start and duration is being provided by this addendum. The NRC has previously sent acceptance of notification at this temporary job site as NRC Docket No. 03035316, Control No. 137541. The attached information is provided as required by license condition 17A.

We trust that this information is sufficient to grant our request for use of CABRERA material license # 06-30556-01 at the temporary job site. This license is currently being used at other sites outside Maryland. The maximum amount of radioactivity possessed concurrently under the license is a small fraction of the CABRERA license possession limits. CABRERA will notify the Regional Administrator, U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, within 30 days of termination of activities at this job site in keeping with license condition 17B.

The U.S. Army Field Support Command (AFSC) has contracted Cabrera Services, Inc. (CABRERA) to characterize the low level radioactive burial site (LLRBS) at the United States Department of Agriculture's (USDA's) Beltsville Agricultural Research Center (BARC) in Beltsville, Maryland. The characterization survey is designed to collect data regarding the nature and extent of chemical and radiological contamination associated with the burial site, in support of development of a Decommissioning Plan in accordance with Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) requirements. The work includes the delineation of burial pits, the excavation of up to four pits (pit numbers 1, 14, 26, and 34), waste segregation, chemical and radiological sampling of soil and groundwater, and securing walls and covering each pit. Excavated materials will be sorted on-site and then packaged and transported to appropriate off-site facilities for treatment and/or disposal in accordance with applicable state and federal regulations. CABRERA intends to utilize its NRC Materials License, number 06-30556-01 Amendment 01, at the USDA BARC LLRBS to accomplish this work. Use of CABRERA's NRC license is necessary because USDA's license does not authorize excavation of buried wastes. This information is being transmitted to you as required by condition 17A of the CABRERA Materials License.
