In 1992, NRC Staff decided that the package with the contents limited to capsules which meet the requirements for special form met the Type B(U) package requirements (1973 Edition). Since both models are under the same CoC they would both meet the requirements for the 1973 edition.

Good Morning Tomas,

International Isotopes may have the opportunity to acquire ownership of a USA/5796B(U) Package. My biggest concern is that the package was constructed under the 1967 Edition of Safety Series 6 and will only be Grandfathered until October 2008. The CoC I have for the package expires August 31, 2007. Is there a way I can determine what criteria this package was fabricated under? It has to be either the 1967 or 1973 Editions. Also the CoC lists two models, the 181375 and 181361. Would it be safe to assume that both Models would have been fabricated under the same Edition since they are listed on the same CoC? I was going to see what I can find in ADAMS but am not certain if what I am looking for would be retrievable.

Do you have any information on this CoC?
