Therefore, please amend the license to change any reference to Gianne E. Howard with Robert E. Dye.

Mr. Dye is qualified by education and experience to perform the duties of acting radiation safety officer. He worked in the Radiation Protection Program at the Duane Arnold Energy Center from 1972 to 1985 when he joined the Environmental Protection Agency at the radiation laboratory in Las Vegas. Mr. Dye was a member of the Nevada Test Site support team and served as the Laboratory Radiation Safety Officer. In 1987 he joined Region 7 and has served as the Office of Radiation and Indoor Air Program Manager since that time. He has also been a backup to the Radiation Safety Officer/Alternate and has served as the Alternate Radiation Safety Officer for the past four months. He received his Bachelors of Science degree in Chemistry in 1972.

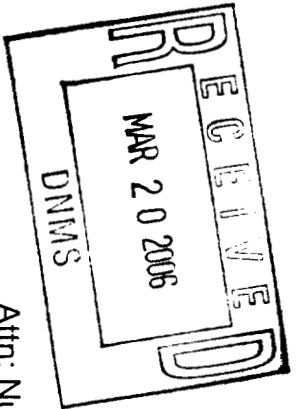
