"ELECTRICAL ENGINEERING BRANCH CONCERNS WITH TECHNICAL
SPECIFICATION TASK FORCE (TSTF)-360, REVISION 1 DC ELECTRICAL
REWRITE"

Dear Members of the TSTF,

During the last TSTF meeting held on February 23, 2006, the Nuclear Regulatory Commission staff stated that there were technical concerns regarding TSTF-360, Revision 1 as written. Enclosed are the concerns of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission staff. We request that you review the enclosed document so that a public meeting can be held within the next 60 days to discuss NRC and industry concerns as well as possible solutions. We believe that the solution will involve incorporating these concerns into a model application, with acceptance criteria, for licensees to follow. This will hopefully result in a more stable, predictable process for future license applications requesting adoption of TSTF-360.
