**ANSWER TO ORDER EA-06-037 REQUIRING COMPLIANCE WITH UPDATED ADVERSARY CHARACTERISTIC FOR TENNESSEE VALLEY AUTHORITY'S (TVA) BROWNS FERRY NUCLEAR PLANT, SEQUOYAH NUCLEAR PLANT, AND WATTS BAR NUCLEAR PLANT**

The subject Order was issued by the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) on March 20, 2006, and sent to the Site Vice Presidents of TVA's Browns Ferry, Sequoyah, and Watts Bar Nuclear Plants. This Answer provides TVA's single, consolidated response to the subject Order.

TVA hereby consents to the subject Order requiring compliance with the updated adversary characteristic associated with the design basis threat (DBT). NRC defines the updated adversary characteristic in Attachment 2 of the subject Order.

As required by the Order, the Browns Ferry, Sequoyah, and Watts Bar Nuclear Plant site security plans will be revised as necessary to implement the Order, and notification of compliance with the Order submitted to NRC, within 60 days of the date of the Order.


