Dear Mr. Downing:

By letter application and letter, both dated February 9, 2006, you requested that the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission terminate your NRC radioactive material license, License No. 13-32491-01, (expiration date of May 31, 2014) which authorized millicurie quantities of four radionuclides, all in bound/non-volatile form. These authorized radionuclides were Hydrogen -3 and Carbon 14 for Research & Development as defined in 10 CFR 30.4, including animal studies, and Chromium-51 and Iodine-125 for in vitro studies. You confirmed in the referenced termination application, as well as in a telephone conversation with you on April 4, 2006, that no radioactive materials have ever been procured or possessed by the licensee under NRC License No. 13-32491-01. Based on information you have provided to us, we have concluded that your licensed facility (located at 10424 Middle Mt. Vernon Road, Mt. Vernon, Indiana) meets NRC criteria for release for unrestricted use, permitting us to terminate it as requested. Accordingly, an amendment is enclosed terminating your NRC license, License No. 13-32491-01.
