Dear Mr. Quick:

This is in reference to your documents providing financial assurance for decommissioning for Nuclear Regulatory Commission License Nos. 29-00170-03, SMB-1260, and SNM-203. In order to continue our review, we need the following additional information:

In a recent audit of all financial assurance instruments and related documents, we identified that your "Certificate of Events" and "Certificate of Resolution" were signed. The signing of these documents certifies that decommissioning activities have, in fact, commenced. However, you are not decommissioning your facilities at this time. Please submit copies of unsigned documents, to demonstrate that these certificates are available for use if needed. Enclosed are copies of the "Model Specimen Certificate of Events" and "Model Specimen Certificate of Resolution" from NUREG-1757, Consolidated NMSS Decommissioning Guidance," Volume 3, "Financial Assurance, Recordkeeping, and Timeliness." The original signed documents will be returned to you in a separate letter.
