In a letter (696-3975) dated March 29, 2006, General Atomics notified the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) of a personnel change within the office of the General Counsel. The initial review reveals that the change is compatible with the organizational structure approved via Amendment 28, dated February 7, 1995.
