In an NRC Form 314, "Certificate Of Disposition of Materials," dated February 23, 2006, Mr. Thomas Templeman contacted the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission and indicated that you wished to terminate your byproduct materials license no. 24-32396-01.

The NRC staff has reviewed your final status surveys. Based on its review, the staff has concluded that no licensable radioactive material was ever procured under this license, as attested to on the NRC Form 314 referenced above.

Based on these conclusions no further remediation or actions with respect to NRC regulated material is required. Your facility is suitable for unrestricted use and NRC license number 24-32396-01 is hereby terminated with the enclosed Amendment No. 02.
