The licensee is an engineering firm located in Lombard, Illinois that performs work in NRC controlled states under the general license granted under reciprocity. The licensee is performing work under the authority of section 150.20 of the regulations (reciprocity). Licensee was performing radiography using a cobalt-60 source of approximately 45 curies at the time of this inspection.

Performance Observations

The inspector toured the facility and checked radiation levels around the perimeter of the shot area as well as looked for proper signs indicating the presence of radioactive material. Independent surveys performed by the inspector did not detect any unexpected reading. Interviews of licensee personnel indicated they had an adequate level of knowledge. Dosimetry readings were at nominal levels. Both radiographers were in possession of current ASNT certification cards. Guide tubes, cranks, and collimators were inspected and found to be in good working order. No violations were noted.
