Dear Mr. Serrano:

This is in reference to your letter dated March 9, 2006 submitting your Final Status Survey Report. In order to continue our review, we need the following additional information:

1. From the description in your letter regarding the areas of use for licensed material, it is unclear which materials were present in which areas. For each area of use, list specifically which licensed materials and which form, sealed or unsealed, were present.
2. The method for a simplified final status survey for the unrestricted release of facilities does not appear to have been followed. Specifically, a 100% scan must be performed and a minimum of 30 wipe tests must be taken for each survey unit. Please resubmit the final status survey following the guidance in NUREG-1757, Volume 2, Appendix B. This guidance may be found on the NRC's website at <http://www.nrc.gov/reading-rm/doc-collections/nuregs/staff/sr1757/>.
3. Submit a statement verifying that no leaking sealed sources have ever been identified at your facility.
