Dear Mr. Johnson:

On January 1, 1959, the Mallinckrodt Chemical Works will transfer all of the nuclear fuel business now being carried on by its Special Metals Division to a wholly owned subsidiary, the Mallinckrodt Nuclear Corporation. The transfer will include physical assets, contracts, licenses, and all other property now being utilized by Mallinckrodt Chemical Works in this business. It is also contemplated that all of the personnel now engaged in these activities will be transferred to the employ of the Mallinckrodt Nuclear Corporation on January 1, 1959.


It is requested that the licenses issued to the Mallinckrodt Chemical Works, identified as SM-33, SM-230 and C-2714, as such licenses have been amended from time to time, be transferred to the Mallinckrodt Nuclear Corporation; or in the alternative, that new licenses identical to those identified above, be issued to such corporation. In either event, the effective date of the licenses should be January 1, 1959.


