ORDER

(Postponing Date for Mandatory Disclosures)

Before us is the April 13, 2006 proposed second joint stipulation of the Applicant, Pa'ina Hawaii, LLC, the NRC Staff, and the Intervenor, Concerned Citizens of Honolulu, to postpone further each party's mandatory disclosures required by 10 C.F.R. §§ 2.336(a),(b) and 2.1203(a). In accordance with the parties' first joint stipulation accepted by our order of February 9, 2006, the mandatory disclosures are to be made by April 24, 2006.

We will discuss with the parties the schedule for mandatory disclosures at the upcoming April 26, 2006 telephone conference. Because the conference is scheduled subsequent to the date such disclosure must be made, the previously ordered date for mandatory disclosures is postponed. In establishing a schedule for concluding the proceeding, we will set a new

date for the parties' mandatory disclosures. So that no party will be surprised, the date for mandatory disclosures may be within ten days of the date of the conference.
