## SPECIAL NUCLEAR MATERIAL LICENSE

Pursuant to the Atomic Energy Act of 1954 and Title 10, Gode of Federal Regulations, Chapter 1, Part 70, "Special Nuclear Material Regulations," and subject to the conditions and limitations incorporated herein, Hallinekrodt Chemical Works, St. Louis, Missouri (hereinafter referred to as the "licensee") is hereby licensed to receive and possess at its plant near Hematite, Missouri, uranium spriched in the U-235 isotope for uso as described in the licensee's application of May 15, 1956, and supplements of June 18, August 9, and August 21, 1956.

This license is subject to all applicable provisions of the Atomic Energy Act: of 1954 and to all applicable rules, regulations and orders of the Commission. It is also subject to the provisions of the Commission's proposed Part 20, 10 CFR, "Standards for Protection Against Radiation," published July 16, 1955, in the Federal Register, until such time as said proposed regulations or revisions thereof shall become effective regulations of the Commission.

In connection with its possession and use of said special nuclear material, the licensee shall observe the procedures set forth in its application of May 15, 1956, and supplements of June 18, August 9, and August 21, 1956,

The provisions of Section 70.32(a) of Part 70, Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, are incorporated harein by reference with the same force and effect as if fully set forth herein.

This license shall expire July 1, 1961.
