Summary: The licensee reported that a TSI Model 3071 Electrostatic Classifier (EC) containing a generally licensed TSI Model 3077 chamber containing 2 millicuries of Kr-85 gas was unknowingly transported between two DuPont facilities. An employee transported the Model 3071 EC by vehicle from the Richmond, Virginia, facility to the Wilmington, Delaware, facility before it was determined that the EC contained a generally licensed Kr-85 Chamber. Both facilities have a specific licenses that support possession of these type licensed devices. The licensee reported that the Richmond facility was not aware that the generally licensed chamber was present at the facility and that subsequently discovered documentation indicated that the device was originally distributed to the Wilmington facility. The licensee was instructed to investigate and document the event and to implement correction actions to prevent recurrence. This information should be available to the NRC for the next scheduled routine inspection. Additionally, the licensee was informed that the new storage location is required to be reported to the NRC in accordance with 10 CFR 31.5(c)8(i).
