Referring to your letter of April 5, 1960, L&R:JCD, regarding our request for 44 kilograms uranium enriched to 10% U²³⁵, this material is required by the Northrop Corporation for the construction of a fuel element in a sub-critical assembly. This assembly is described in some detail in their license application for SNM 342 as amended on December 23, 1959. This application is AEC Docket 70-365.




