Dear Mr. Reynolds:

This is in reference to your letter dated February 24, 2006 requesting to amend Nuclear Regulatory Commission License No. 47-25265-01 and to the telephone discussion between Loren Bertocci's staff and myself on April 4, 2006. In order to continue our review, we need the following additional information:

It has been greater than thirty days since the issuance of our letter of March 8, 2006, requesting additional information on the Change of Ownership and as of this date, we have not received the information. Normally, the licensing action would be voided for failing to provide the required information. However, discussions with your staff on April 4, 2006, indicated that all remaining licensed material had been shipped off-site for disposal and that a request to terminate the license would be submitted. For the purpose of decommissioning, you should review the guidance in NUREG-1757, "Consolidated NMSS Decommissioning Guidance." Please submit the information that was requested in our February 24, 2006, letter if you decide that you are not terminating your license by May 14, 2006, otherwise, submit the request to terminate the license by the above date.

Current NRC regulations and guidance are included on the NRC's website at www.nrc.gov; select **Nuclear Materials; Medical, Industrial, and Academic Uses of Nuclear Material**; then **Toolkit Index Page**. Or you may obtain these documents by contacting the Government Printing Office (GPO) toll-free at 1-888-293-6498. The GPO is open from 7:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. EST, Monday through Friday (except Federal holidays).

We will continue our review upon receipt of this information. Please reply to my attention at the Region I Office and refer to Mail Control No. 138506. If you have any technical questions regarding this deficiency letter, please call me at (610) 337-5075.
