Your letter dated February 7, 2006, requested a change in the name of your hospital. However, you did not indicate whether a change in ownership or control of your hospital had also occurred. If a change in ownership or control has occurred or will be occurring please provide the information requested in Appendix G, NUREG 1556, Vol. 9, Rev. 1.

In you next future amendment request please specify possession limits for materials in 10 CFR 35.400 and materials in 10 CFR 35.1000.

You will be periodically inspected by NRC. Failure to conduct your program in accordance with NRC regulations, license conditions, and representations made in your license application and supplemental correspondence with NRC will result in enforcement action against you. This could include issuance of a notice of violation, or imposition of a civil penalty, or an order suspending, modifying or revoking your license as specified in the General Statement of Policy and Procedure for NRC Enforcement Actions. Since serious consequences to employees and the public can result from failure to comply with NRC requirements, prompt and vigorous enforcement action will be taken when dealing with licensees who do not achieve the necessary meticulous attention to detail and the high standard of compliance which NRC expects of its licensees.
