SUBJECT: SUMMARY OF APRIL 19, 2006, MEETING WITH TRANSNUCLEAR ON

TN-40 PACKAGE (DOCKET NO. 71-9313, TAC NO. L23959)

On April 19, 2006, Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff and representatives of Transnuclear Inc. (TN) held a pre-application meeting to discuss certification of TN-40 storage cask for transport. The discussion at the meeting focused on the proposed 1/3-scale impact limiters test plan followed by TN's proprietary presentation on their Burnup Credit methodology in satisfying regulatory criticality safety requirements for transport. Moderator Exclusion was also discussed briefly at the end. A list of the attendees is shown in Attachment 1.

Currently, there are 20 TN-40 casks loaded and placed on the pad at the Prairie Island facility. There is a plan to load an additional 9 casks. The casks do not meet existing NRC technical guidance standards with regard to criticality control for transportation packages. TN has proposed to use Burnup Credit in order to qualify the TN-40 casks for transport.

TN presented their test plan for qualifying the design of impact limiters using four 1/3-scale impact limiters and a dummy cask (Attachment 2). The plan include side, slap-down, and end drops. The staff indicated that a CG-over-corner drop would be also needed.

The remaining part of the meeting was closed to the public in order for TN to present their proprietary Burnup Credit methodology (Attachment 3). TN also discussed briefly the Moderator Exclusion option at the end. TN indicated that they are planning to submit the application sometime in June 2006.

No regulatory decisions were made at the meeting.
