Let me rephrase my original question. Is Mr. Nakasone going to work as an authorized user or as an ancillary personnel? I guess the answer is as an AU but please verify. If so, then please change the term "ancillary personnel" to "authorized user" in your original request (Item 7.2, Item 1).

You still need to apply for an amendment if you want an individual (AU) to use material unsupervised (listed on the license). However, an individual not listed on the license, but trained by you, can work under your supervision without the need to be listed on the license.


