Dear Mr. Quintana:

By letter dated February 14, 2006, GENE submitted for U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff review Topical Report (TR) NEDE-32906P, Revision 2, "TRACG Application for Anticipated Operational Occurrences (AOO) Transient Analyses." The NRC staff has performed an acceptance review of NEDE-32906P, Revision 2. We have found that the material presented is sufficient to begin our comprehensive review. The NRC staff expects to issue its request for additional information by May 15, 2006, and issue its draft safety evaluation by July 30, 2006, and estimates that the review will require approximately 360 staff hours including project management time. The review schedule milestones and estimated review costs were discussed and agreed upon in a telephone conference between Jim Harrison and the NRC staff on April 20, 2006.

Section 170.21 of Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* requires that TRs are subject to fees based on the full cost of the review. You did not request a fee waiver; therefore, NRC staff hours will be billed accordingly.
