

# PROPOSED EXPORT OF RADIOACTIVELY CONTAMINATED LEAD FROM THE UK TO DURATEK, OAK RIDGE, TENNESSEE

I enclose for your attention an application for the export from the UK to the USA of 18 tonnes of radioactively contaminated lead to Duratek for the purposes of a trial process.

Within the European Union the export of radioactive waste, is regulated in accordance with EC Directive 92/3 Euratom (on the transfrontier shipment of radioactive waste). The Directive includes provisions covering the export of radioactive waste. In the UK the Directive is implemented by the Transfrontier Shipment of Radioactive Waste Regulations 1993 (the Regulations). Please note that the Regulations are separate to, and distinct from, the IAEA and UK transport requirements.

The Environment Agency is the competent authority for the Regulations in England and Wales and is required to consult with, and seek approval of, the relevant competent authorities in the country of destination. For the purposes of the Regulations this consignment of lead is considered under the Regulations to be radioactive waste.

A copy of both the application from British Nuclear Group (BNG) and the Approval form are appended. Section 20 of the Approval form provides the opportunity for the NRC to approve or refuse the proposed shipment. We will not grant the nuthorisation to BNG without the approval of the NRC.

If you wish to approve please tick the YES box at Section 20 and include any conditions you may wish to make. I will impose a small number of conditions, which will include the requirement on BNG to recept back the consignment if it cannot for any reason be completed. In addition BNG/Duratek will have to report on the outcome of the trial within 6 months of its completion. It should then be signed, dated and stamped.

If you wish to refuse the shipment please tick the NO box at Section 20 and provide your reason for refusal. It should then be signed, dated and stamped.

# APPROVAL BY THE COMPETENT AUTHORITIES CONSULTED

# NOTE

- 1. The competent authorities responsible for issuing the authorization for the radioactive waste shipment should complete boxes 17 and 18 immediately on receipt of the application and enter the registration number at the top of each section of the standard document. They should then make sufficient copies of section 2 to send to any other competent authorities whose approval is required for the shipment(s) to be authorized ("the competent authority consulted"). For each competent authority to be consulted, box 19 should be completed on a copy of section 2; that copy of section 2, together with a copy of section 1, should be sent to the competent authority to be consulted named therein.
- 2. The competent authority consulted should make any necessary additional entries in box 19 and should give the application due consideration. Within two months from the date of receipt it should complete box 20 and return the original copy of section 2 to the competent authority responsible for issuing the authorization. An extension of up to one month in the time required to consider an application may be requested by the competent authority consulted. Failure to complete and return the form by the due time shall be taken as deemed approval of the shipment application, subject to Arricle 6 (4) of Directive 92/3/Euratom.

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# COMMISSION DECISION

# of 1 October 1993

establishing the standard document for the supervision and control of shipments of radioactive waste referred to in Council Directive 92/3/Euratom

(93/552/Euratom)

# THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES.

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Atomic Energy Community;

Having regard to Council Directive 92/3/Euratom of 3 February 1992 on the supervision and control of shipments of radioactive waste between Member States and into and out of the Community, and in particular Article 20 thereof,

Whereas by virtue of Directive 92/3/Euraiom the Commission is required to establish a standard document;

Whereas that Directive applies not only to shipments of radioactive waste between Member States but also to imports into and exports out of the Community of such waste and to its transit through the Community from a third country to another third country,

Whereas under certain circumstances an application may be sent in respect of more than one shipment:

Whereas it is appropriate to include all these cases in a uniform document, with a number of sections reflecting the various cases envisaged by the Directive;

Whereas the measures provided for in this Decision are in accordance with the opinion of the Committee instituted under Article 19 of that Directive.

HAS ADOPTED THIS DECISION:

### Article 1

The standard document contained in the Annex shall be used in respect of any shipments of radioactive waste between Member States or into and out of the Community within the scope of Directive 92/3/Euratom.

# Article 2

The standard document must be completed in accordance with the notes contained in its different sections.

# Article 3

- 1. The standard document shall be printed in black ink on white paper, weighing at least 40 grams per square metre, and its strength should be such that in normal use it does not easily tear or crease.
- 2. The standard document shall measure 210 by 297 mm (A4) with a maximum tolerance as to length of 5 mm less and 8 mm more.
- 3. Member States may require that the forms show the name and address of the printer or a mark enabling the printer to be identified. They may also make private printing of the forms conditional on prior approval.

### Article 4

Member States shall take the measures necessary to comply with this Decision not later than 1 January 1994.

### Article 5

This Decision is addressed to the Member States.
