Subject: Notice of License Request for Pa'ina Hawaii-Irradiator in Honolulu, HI

The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC), RIV office in Arlington, Texas, received a license application request from Pa'ina Hawaii, LLC, for the operation of an underwater pool type commercial irradiator. The proposed location is nearby the Honolulu airport. NRC plans to conduct several public meetings and precicensing inspections in Hawaii during the construction phase. The first public meeting is going to be held in Hawaii on August 31, 2005. Debra Tom from the State of Hawaii, Coastal Zone Management Program, asked us to keep you informed of this process. Our point of contact is Tony Gaines. He will be calling you next week so we could get a better understanding of the Federal Consistency regulations on a National level.
