Dear Mr. Muench:

Thank you for your letter dated April 14, 2006, in response to our February 1, 2006, letter and integrated inspection report. In your letter you contested one Green noncited violation of License Condition 2.C.(5), "Fire Protection (Section 9.5.1, SER; Section 9.5.1.8, SSER 5)," for failure to ensure that redundant trains of safe shutdown systems in the same fire area were free of fire damage. The NRC inspection report concluded that a Green noncited violation of License Condition 2.C.(5) existed because of the Wolf Creek Generating Station's crediting the use of manual actions to mitigate the effects of fire damage in lieu of providing the physical protection required by 10 CFR Part 50, Appendix R, Section III.G.2. Wolf Creek Nuclear Operating Corporation's position is that the Wolf Creek Generating Station complied with the requirements of its approved fire protection program as defined in License Condition 2.C.(5); therefore, a violation did not occur. You have requested that the NRC reconsider our conclusion and find that a violation of License Condition 2.C.(5) did not occur.

The NRC is reviewing your request and will inform you of the results of our review by separate correspondence.
