RE: REQUEST TO TRANSFER TX-1153-S-102-S TO NRC

Dear Mr. Miller:

In response to your request to transfer Registration Certificate TX-1153-S-102-S from the State of Texas to the Nuclear Regulatory Commission in letter dated March 31, 2005, and based on the information received from the State of Texas in letter dated April 27, 2005, we have completed your request. Texas Registration Certificate TX-1153-S-102-S has been transferred to and re-issued by NRC as Registration Certificate NR-1235-S-102-S. A copy of the registration certificate is enclosed.

Please note that the sources, which had been previously registered by the State of Texas under registration No. TX-1153-S-102-S, also included the following sources with NARM/NORM materials: BM06-22 (Sodium-22, 0.5 mCi), BM06-57 (Cobalt-57, 15 mCi), and BM06-68 (Germanium-68, 0.5 mCi). However, registration No. NR-1235-S-102-S lists those sources only containing byproduct materials in accordance with 10CFR 30.71.

If the sealed source or device contains NARM or NORM material, then the source or device is under the regulatory jurisdiction of the State where you are located. Although NRC maintains the National Sealed Source and Device Registry (NSSDR) that includes such materials, the applications for registration and amendments for sealed sources or devices containing NARM and NORM sources must be filed with the host State. The States may choose to issue a registration certificate for NARM or NORM materials and, when they do, the States send a copy of the source and design registrations to NRC to be placed in the NSSDR.

Please be advised that you must manufacture and distribute the product in accordance with the statements and representations contained in your application, with enclosures thereto, and the information set out in your registration certificate. As a general rule, you must request and obtain an amendment to the certificate before you make changes or modifications to the information submitted to obtain the certificate.

Please read over the registration certificate in its entirety and notify us immediately of any errors or omissions. You are obligated to notify us promptly in writing should you decide to no longer manufacture or offer service support for the product.

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Please be aware that, as a holder of an NRC registration, you may be subject to the NRC's licensing and inspection fees in accordance with 10 CFR Part 170, and annual fees in accordance with 10 CFR Part 171.
