Subject: Groundwater Investigation

Hello Bill and Don,
This e-mail is a follow-up to last weeks bi-weekly conf call.

During that call several significant developments related to the groundwater investigation were brought to the attention of the participants. We were pleased with the scope of the new information presented. Based upon the information provided to date, we believe that the investigation has been well planned and executed, and have every reason to believe that Entergy and its contractors will continue to do an adequate job.

In keeping with our role of providing an outside assessment of the ongoing groundwater investigation, we would like to arrange for a more comprehensive update.

We are interested in the status of the first round of the investigation, including details of well installation (depth below ground surface, elevation of ground surface, depth to water, screened depth(s), etc.), preliminary assessments of water transport in the fractures and overburden, interconnection of wells, etc. Also, we would like a description/map of planned locations for all next round wells, the current version of the prioritization/schedule for well installation, the rationale for location selection, thoughts on potential sources of contamination beyond the SFP, and any other relevant information.

A copy of a written report or update from your hydrology consultant might be a good place to start, and may provide the information we need to adequately assess the status and path forward of the investigation. If additional information is needed, we can discuss how to best acquire that information after reading the material provided (additional written report, conf call, face-to-face meeting, etc.)

Also, we would like a more detailed description of the stormdrain system, including all locations, interconnections, and which ones flow directly to the river (1, 2, 12, 14, . . .), and concentrations noted at each.

Also, for scheduling purposes, as soon as it can be estimated, we would appreciate a target date (week?) for the complete round of phase one well split samples with DEC and NRC that has been agreed to.
