Drill and Exercise Guidelines

- Demonstrate key skills to successfully meet challenges posed by a security event
- Consideration of Policy Issues
 - Exercise Evaluation Methodology (EEM)
 - Overlap with force-on-force exercises
- Stakeholders will be offered the opportunity to comment on proposed guidelines



United States Nuclear Regulatory Commission

Going Forward

- Conduct baseline drills (industry-wide)
 - Each site over a 3-year period
- Final implementation
 - Biennial exercise once in a 6-year cycle
- Review of EP regulations and guidance
