SECOND JOINT STIPULATION AND ORDER REGARDING DISCLOSURES

WHEREAS, on January 24, 2006, the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board ("Board") issued an order granting the request of petitioner Concerned Citizens of Honolulu ("Concerned Citizens") for a hearing on the application submitted by Pa'ina Hawaii, LLC ("Applicant") for a license for possession and use of byproduct material;

WHEREAS, the Board's January 24, 2006 order admitted for hearing Concerned Citizens' first environmental contention and the first portion of Concerned Citizens' second environmental contention;

WHEREAS, on March 24, 2006, the Board issued an order granting three of Concerned Citizens' contentions regarding safety;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the February 8, 2006 Joint Stipulation regarding mandatory document disclosure, the Board's March 24, 2006 order triggered a thirty (30)-day period for the Parties to make disclosures pursuant to 10 C.F.R. § 2.336(a) and (b) and 10 C.F.R. § 2.1203(a);

WHEREAS, the Board currently has pending before it the Nuclear Regulatory Commission ("NRC") Staff's and Concerned Citizens' March 20, 2006 Joint Motion to Dismiss Environmental Contentions, which, if granted, would resolve both admitted environmental contentions;


WHEREAS, the Commission currently has pending before it the Applicant's April 3, 2006 Appeal of LBP-06-04 and LBP-06-12, which, if granted, would dispose of both admitted environmental contentions and one admitted safety contention; and

WHEREAS, Concerned Citizens, the Applicant, and the NRC Staff (collectively, "the Parties") believe it would promote the efficient and expeditious resolution of these proceedings if, prior to preparing their disclosures, the Parties knew the full scope of the issues that will be heard;

NOW THEREFORE, it is stipulated and agreed to by the Parties as follows:

The Parties shall have thirty (30) days from the latter of the Board's ruling on the Joint Motion to Dismiss Environmental Contentions and the NRC's ruling on the Applicant's appeal to make the disclosures required by 10 C.F.R. § 2.336(a) and (b) and 10 C.F.R. § 2.1203(a).




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
