Meaning, they would have to have a procedure demonstrating good health physics practices. Things like, personnel air monitors, surveying the inside of the cab of the truck to very contamination levels, inspection of the AC filters, etc. What they chose to do would be up to their RSO. Assuming that they implemented good HP practices I don't see any problem with them allowing their truck drivers to drink WATER in the restricted area.
