As requested, Orion Genomics LLC is replying to the Notice of Violation dated April 26, 2006.

The reason for the violation is due to the fact that the original Radiation Safety Officer (RSO), Robert Freese, terminated his employment at Orion Genomics in 2002. A qualified RSO replacement was not assigned since no radioactive materials were ever purchased and no plans had been made to purchase or work with radioactive materials since his departure.

Orion Genomics LLC is requesting an immediate termination of License Number 24-32213-01 as corrective action to avoid any further violations.

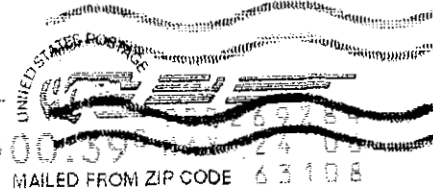
