Dear Mr. Goforth:

This refers to your letter dated May 25, 2006, and its enclosure. Your letter requested amendment to the above license to authorize discontinuation of use of personal monitoring devices by your personnel.

Requirements for individual monitoring of internal and external occupational dose are specified in 10 CFR 20.1502. Item 10 (Radiation Safety Program) of your application dated March 26, 2001, provides you with the option to either monitor your personnel for exposure to radiation or maintain, for inspection by NRC, documentation that demonstrates that unmonitored individuals are not likely to receive, in one year, a radiation dose in excess of 10 percent of the allowable limits in 10 CFR Part 20. The application is incorporated into your license as part of Condition 23 of the license. Therefore, your license does not need to be amended in order to discontinue the use of personal monitoring devices.

We are returning your letter and its enclosure without a review. Thank you for your cooperation.
