Enclosed is the summary of the May 16 and 17, 2006, Technical Exchange and Management Meeting between the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) and the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE). The purpose of this meeting was to discuss the requirements of 10 CFR Part 63 as they relate to the Preclosure Safety Analysis (PCSA) and supporting information. The discussions focused on several key aspects of the PCSA, including: the PCSA process, the level of information necessary to support the NRC's review of the PCSA, and estimating the reliability of structures, systems, and components.

The meeting was held at the DOE office in Las Vegas, Nevada, and via videoconferencing to NRC Headquarters in Rockville, Maryland, and the Center for Nuclear Waste Regulatory Analyses in San Antonio, Texas.
