The NRC Region III received a Fax on 05/26/06 from Herlacher Angleton Associates Engineering Services (HAA), an environmental site assessor. The HAA inquired about a property in Fenton, MO, a property that was formerly owned by Louisiana-Pacific Corporation (LPC). According to the HAA, LPC who owned the property, was an NRC licensee. HAA inquired whether LPC had used radioactive materials at the site and whether there were residual traces of this radioactive material.

Based on the licensing database, LPC license was terminated on March 5, 1996, and was last inspected by the NRC in June 1991. Based on the NRC records, the licensee only possessed fixed gauges containing Cs-137 sealed source, and did not have a history of leaking sources during the termination of the license in 1996.

This above information was communicated by phone to Mr. James Foley, the HAA scientist. According to Mr. Foley, we had allayed his fear about the property that was formerly owned by LPC, and he was appreciative to our prompt response. I did explain to Mr. Foley that by terminating the license, we at NRC have to be assured that licensed materials described in the license were properly disposed or transferred prior to the termination of the license in March 1996.
