This letter is in response to a verbal request made by your staff regarding the risk analysis conducted by the Nuclear Regulatory Commission in support of a decision we made regarding your appeal of a White finding discussed in your letter of April 27, 2006, and our response dated May 18, 2006.

The attached analysis was conducted by an Appeal Board consisting of a Senior Reactor Analyst (SRA) from Region I, an SRA from Region II, and an enforcement specialist.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.390 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," a copy of this letter will be available electronically for public inspection in the NRC Public Document Room or from the Publicly Available Records (PARS) component of NRC's document system (ADAMS).
