Waiver_Purpose: This requested information will be used by the NM Enviromental Law Center (a non-profit, public interest corporation) in preparation for a federal court appeal. The information will also be

made available here in the Law Center's library.

Waiver_ExtentToExtractAnalyze: The requested information will be extracted and analyzed for information that could be helpful in the federal appeal process and to aid the NM communities that have been adversely affected by mine radiation.

Waiver_SpecificActivityQuals: The NM Environmental Law Center is a non-profit, public interest law firm that houses attorneys with the qualifications to extract relevant and helpful information to the NM communities that it serves. The use of the information in the federal appeal process will likely make the information available in the adjudicatory record as well as in the firm's library, which will greatly contribute to the public understanding for communities specifically interested and involved in this federal appeal, specifically Northern New Mexico, and other members of the public involved in similar situations or with interest in the topic.

Waiver_ImpactPublicUnderstanding: The likely impact on the public's understanding of this subject has the capability of being very great, compared to the current understanding, specifically for those NM communities involved in the appeal, or facing similar situations.
