By letter dated March 27, 2006, you provided notification to this office that you would initiate certain activities under the subject license, in 7 days. License Condition 14 requires at least 14 day written notification prior to initiating activities at each temporary job site, excluding routine packaging or repackaging for purposes of transporting and jobs not requiring a site specific work package, or characterization and/or final surveys where radioactive materials and/or radiation are not likely to be detected. Nonetheless, due to the time-critical nature of the work being performed for the U.S. Navy at the Marine Corps Air Station, Cherry Point, North Carolina, the staff accepts and considers your notification as timely.

Please note that this should not be construed as a general waiver of the requirements under your license, as this office expects licensees to be in compliance with all license conditions.
