CONTRARY TO THIS REQUIREMENT, THE LICENSEE'S SHIPPING PAPERS CONTAINED DATED SHIPPING NAME AND UN NUMBER. LICENSEE AGREES TO CORRECT THIS DOCUMENT PRIOR TO ANY FUTURE LICENSED MATERIAL TRANSPORT.
