

A KM truck transporting a package containing approximately 350 gm of YC in three glass vials was destined for an independent testing lab on October 2, 1981. During transport the truck ^{door} inadvertently came open losing the above package. The package fell to the highway apparently breaking the three glass vials and releasing the contents to the inside of the package. When the material fell from the truck an unidentified individual radioed the KM truck that he had lost a package. The truck driver immediately returned to the location where he had lost the package only to discover that an OK Department of Transportation employee had breached the package spilling approximately 19 gm of the YC material. He was immediately rushed to the Muskogee General Hospital where his hands and feet were decontaminated by KM personnel. Successful decontamination was evidenced by a radiation survey conducted by KM personnel. A sample of urine was taken at this time and another sample was requested 24 h hence, all of which are to be analyzed by KM.

Material was lost at I-40 and US 69 at the Chectoah overpass. All residual YC at this location was removed by KM personnel.
