The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff evaluated the impacts of high winds in its "Environmental Impact Statement for the Proposed National Enrichment Facility in Lea County, New Mexico," NUREG-1790. The staff concluded that the impacts would be small. NRC staff continues to stand by its position as we have stated in previous emails to you dated April 10, 2006, April 14, 2006, and May 10, 2006.
