Dear Mr. Corte:

By letter dated May 9, 2006, Western Nuclear, Inc. (WNI) informed the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff that additional wells were added to the ground water extraction program for the year 2006. WNI added wells 4R and 30 because wells 4E and C were not producing enough water to meet the ground water extraction volume required in License Condition 74C. NRC staff concurs with this decision.
