WORKSHOP OVERVIEW

The INEX 3 Consequence Management Exercises investigated how participating countries would respond to an emergency resulting in widespread radiological contamination of the environment. The focus was on experiences and issues identified in the medium to longer term period after such an event. The International Workshop on the INEX 3 Consequence Management Exercises will now provide a forum for countries who conducted an INEX 3 exercise or who are interested in consequence management issues to discuss and investigate in a lively and collegial setting the outcomes and issues related to the INEX 3 exercise objectives.

Workshop participants will share their national experiences, investigate similarities and variations in approaches, analyse the implications on decision-making, and identify specific and cross-cutting issues needing further examination. Workshop discussions will focus on the information and issues identified from the national INEX 3 evaluations and during the workshop. A broad range of national representatives have been invited to attend, including senior civil servants, the emergency management community, technical managers, external agencies, local and regional authorities, business, industry, and the media. Based on these experiences and discussions, a series of recommended strategies for improving consequence management arrangements and addressing the key areas of countermeasures, recovery, and public information, with a view towards cross-cutting issues such as public acceptance and stakeholder involvement, will emerge.

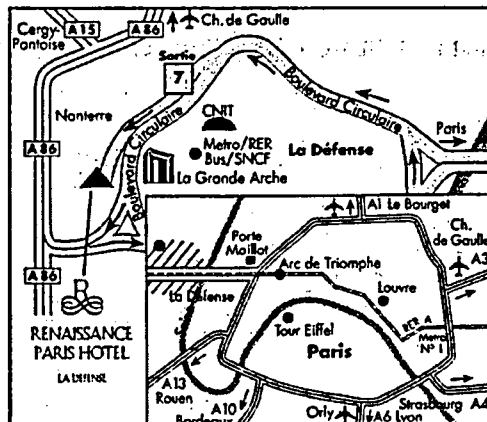
