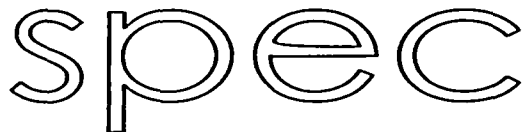

Source Production and Equipment Company (SPEC) has developed and maintains a quality system applicable to all items important to safety in accordance with the requirements of 10 CFR, Part 71, Subpart H. SPEC's quality system requires conformance with the applicable requirements of 10 CFR Part 21. It is SPEC's policy that work on radioactive material packages be accomplished in accordance with this quality system as described in the QA Program and implemented in the Quality System Procedure Manual (QSPM), Work Instructions and engineering documents.

The Senior Quality Management Council (SQMC) is responsible for establishing quality policy and regularly assessing the scope, status, implementation, suitability and effectiveness of the QA Program. The President presides over the SQMC.

Senior Management has the authority to revise the provisions of the QSPM.

Senior Management has delegated authority to Quality Assurance Management for implementing, maintaining and continually improving the quality system.
